Step-by-Step Scholarship Request Instructions

1. Create your NeighborWorks Training account.
Use the link above to access the site. If you already have an account, go to #2.
On the top, right of the page, click on Create Account.
Follow the instructions and prompts on the page to create your account.
After your account is created, use the link above to return to the scholarship page.
2. After you have created your account.
Use the scholarship link above or copy and paste the link

Read the information on that page.
Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the "Apply for this Scholarship" button.
Select your classes from the list.
Choose from the list of available courses and select your preferred courses (First Choice).
Select alternate courses (Second Choice) in case your preferred course is at capacity or is canceled.
Scroll down the page and check the appropriate boxes under "Requested Support".
Enter the scholarship code where requested.
Click the "Send Application" button.
3. You will be sent an automated email that your scholarship was submitted. To verify if your scholarship was submitted, go to <http://training.nw5.org>.
Log-in to your account.
On the My Account page, scroll down to My Events. If you submitted an application, you will see the event listed there.
You can also use this page to review your scholarship status.
