THE UNDERSIGNED (SYSTEM OWNER) AGREES:

- Proposed work must be completed within one (1) year of executing a loan or grant agreement. Applicants must promptly notify Rural Community Assistance Corporation about any unforeseen delays and provide justification for any time extension requests.
- To allow access to the property and cooperate in: 1) a pre-inspection to validate the emergency is drought-related and evaluate project alternatives for the most cost effective solution, 2) a post (after work is completed) inspection to inspect the work and provide water conservation information and 3) other inspections/visits by the State and/or Rural Community Assistance Corporation that may be requested with sufficient prior notice.
- Be receptive to participate in receiving educational materials on water system operations and maintenance, water quality and testing and water conservation measures and self-certify that water conservation measures will be implemented (costs for water analysis can possibly be included in loan/grant).
- Agree to install treatment devices needed for water treatment to meet State water quality standards (cost can possibly be included in loan/grant).
- Provide all information required in this application and cooperate with Rural Community Assistance Corporation in providing any additional information necessary and requested to determine eligibility, property issues, occupancy, etc.
- If grant assistance is provided, the full grant amount will be due and payable in full upon sale or transfer of the property within five (5) years of project completion.
