RCAC will supply all answers to all Bidders in the form of an Addendum. No questions will be addressed by RCAC after this date and time.

The successful Bidder shall be licensed in accordance with provisions of the Business and Professions Code and shall possess a valid State Contractor's License Class "A". Each license shall

be valid at the time of bid opening and shall be maintained in good standing throughout the successful Bidder's performance of the work and during the applicable warranty period Construction Agreement concerning State prevailing wages, and compliance with other regulatory requirements. These requirements are imposed on RCAC as a condition to its receiving the grant funds for this Project. It is imperative that all required forms be accurately and fully completed to the satisfaction of RCAC which has discretion to withhold funding in the event of any errors in completing those forms. Thus, failure to complete those forms accurately and fully will result in the disqualification of the bid.

The Engineer's estimate for the base bid items of this work is **\$274,800.**

The contract duration shall be **10 months from contract execution.**

Each bid shall be submitted on a form furnished as part of the contract documents. Each bid shall be sealed and delivered to RCAC at the location designated in this notice for the opening of proposals at or before the time in this notice provided. The Bidder will enter into a contract with RCAC and furnish the required payment and performance bonds and certificates of insurance and endorsements if awarded the work.

Due to recent changes in the insurance industry practices, it has become necessary for RCAC to very carefully examine its requirements relating to Contractor-provided insurance for the proposed contract.

You will be held to comply with the insurance requirements as specified by RCAC herein, and in the event of your failure or inability to meet the insurance requirements after the award of bid, RCAC shall have the right to consider such failure to be a material noncompliance by the successful Bidder and will look to exercise its right by rejecting the bids. It is recommended that you carefully review these requirements with your insurance agent/representative to determine your ability to comply with the insurance requirements, as specified.

RCAC has endeavored to develop particularly fair and equitable provisions relating to indemnification, liability and related insurance for both RCAC and the Contractor.

You are required to submit a certificate, after contract execution. Signing the bid form indicates that you have reviewed and understand the insurance requirements and that you have the ability to provide insurance in accordance with the Specified Provisions. See Bid Form.
